This brochure identifies primary care clinics that are available in Princeton. It also includes their location, contact information, and gives transportation options for getting to them.

Primary Care Facilities

Cascade Medical Clinic 250-295-4482

This clinic is at Princeton General Hospital located at 98 Ridgewood Road, just off Highway 3, east of downtown. There are four doctors and a nurse practitioner providing primary care at this clinic.

Princeton Medical Centre 250-295-0091

There is one family physician at this clinic who will be retiring within the next few months; for more information please call the clinic. Princeton Medical Centre is located at 77 Billiter Avenue.

Princeton Secondary School Youth Clinic

This clinic is available to PSS students. The clinic is open from 1:00 - 3:00 pm on Tuesdays.

Please note: Your family physician or nurse practitioner provides primary care that may lead to a referral to a specialist or to one of the several health care services available in Princeton. The Princeton Health Care Steering Committee is preparing a pamphlet that will have an extensive list of available health services. It will be made available to the public in the near future.

For residents of Princeton who do not have access to personal transportation, you can get information on any of the following services by calling Community Services at 250-295-6666. They will help you arrange transportation to your medical appointment in Princeton.

1. **HandiDart Bus Service**

Local bus service is available on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8:30 am - 12:00 noon and 1:00-3:45 pm. Pick up can be made at your home as long as you live within the town limits. There is a \$1.50 charge per trip.

Bus service to Penticton is available on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Pick up starts at 7:30 am and can be arranged from any convenient downtown location or at your own home if within Princeton town boundaries. Reservations are required and medical appointments take priority over leisure bookings. There is an \$8.00 charge for this service.

2. **Princeton Taxi**

This service is available to all Princeton and Area residents. Typical charge for a one-way trip from downtown to Princeton General Hospital is \$10.00. In exceptional circumstances, taxi vouchers are available by calling 250-295-6666.

3. **Volunteer Drivers**
